

Learning for this term:	
English	Through a range of texts about the Victorians, we will learn how to explore different viewpoints. We will understand how to write effective formal letters as well as diary entries and biographies.
Maths	We will be reviewing our knowledge of place values up to 1,000,000 as well as fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also explore Roman Numerals, converting units of measures and 3D shapes.
Science	We will continue developing our understanding of solids, liquids and gases before moving onto a unit of work based on electricity. We will be comparing how different components function and will develop our scientific understanding by carrying out investigations using circuits.
Geography	We will be able to locate and name the countries associated with the British Empire.
History	We will learn about the Victorian era and explore what life was like for a Victorian child. We will also learn about the Industrial Revolution, and the impact this had on people's lives today.
RE	We will learn more about the Christian faith and how understand how religion and world views relate to the news.
Computing	We will learn more about coding using the program 'Scratch' and continue to develop our understanding on being safe online.
Music	We will be learning to play the ukulele using the four chords C, F, G and A minor and practising different strumming patterns.
PE	This term, we will be focusing on a range of tennis skills including basic shots and applying control when returning the ball. We will also practise striking and fielding skills when playing rounders.
PSHE	We will be learning about rights and responsibilities and being the best that we can be. We will also learn about how to support our local communities.
Art/D&T	We will be studying the work of William Morris and will learn to replicate his artwork by doing block printing.
