



### Home-Learning

#### Reading

- Read at least 5 times a week.
- Earn house points for every read you do!

#### **TTRockstars**

- Complete 20 sessions per week.
- The Year 4 objective is for your child to know <u>all</u> of their times tables and corresponding division facts up to and including 12x12.
- There is a national test for times tables in Year 4. They have six seconds to answer each question!

#### **Spelling**

• We will be using a new spelling programme this year which builds on the RWI that the children have previously used.

#### **MyMaths**

Home-learning set on MyMaths will reflect and embed skills learned in class from previous weeks. Your child's password will be in their home-school diary.

## Reading Expectations (At Home)

- We expect children to read to an adult at 5 times a week (ideally every day).
- Record title of the book and the page number in the homeschool diary.
- A varied diet of texts is encouraged: school books, own books, instructions, magazines, audiobooks.
- Ask your children questions about the book to check they have understood what they have read (please see your child's home-school diary for suggested comprehension questions).
- Discuss new and unfamiliar words.
- Reading <u>to</u> children or reading books together is great! We also encourage reading in home languages.

### Writing Expectations

- °Handwriting Children should form each letter by starting in the correct place and joining with lead in and lead out.
- °Spelling Children should know, read and be able to spell Y1, Y2 and Y3 words in their written work. These words are in the back of the home-school diary. Children should be working towards knowing, reading and spelling Y4 common exception words.
- °Children should be able to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces accurately these are basic skills.

#### **Home-School Diaries**

- ODiaries will be signed on a Friday by the teacher.
- ° Parent signatures will be checked every Monday.
- Home-school diaries will be used as the main form of communication between home and school. Please check for messages every night and help children to remember to bring their diary in every day.
- Please ensure pages 0, 5, 7 and 8 in diaries have been signed.
- There is space to record reading on the <u>right</u>. Children earn house points for reading entries.
- $\circ$  Additional cost for replacement diary is £2 (and these are limited!)
