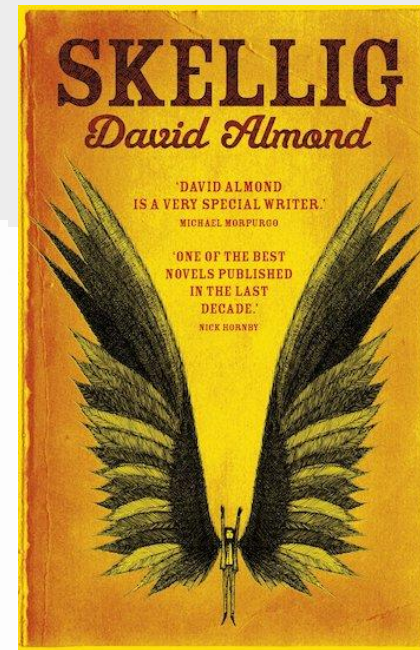

# Home Learning

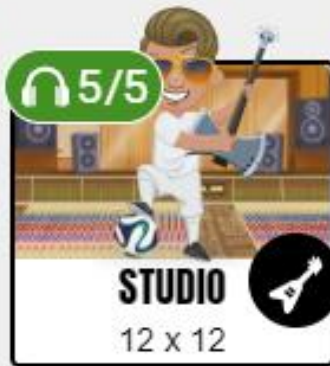
- Weekly MyMaths

# Spellings

- Weekly lists linked to the KS2 spelling rules
- Regular practice in school and at home
- Personalised lists in diaries



# Reading

- We expect children to read at least 5 times a week (ideally every day).
- House points given for each time they read.
- A mixture of reading independently and aloud to an adult.
- Variety of genres/authors etc.



# Home School Diaries/Reading Record

- Please sign them each weekend – the teacher will sign each week.
- There is space to record reading on the right. A brief comment is fine; we check this weekly. Include book title and page numbers
- Easy communication between parent/carer and teacher
