

Learning for this term:	
English	We will be practising how to write excellent sentences using the correct punctuation and using expanded noun phrases and conjunctions.
Maths	We will be reviewing our knowledge of place value and learning about three-digit numbers. We will be using formal written methods and mental strategies for addition and subtraction.
Science	We will be exploring healthy eating, food categories, animal classification including food chains, our skeleton and muscles.
Geography	In support of our topic, we will be learning about land use and settlements and making comparisons between now and the Stone Age / Iron Age.
History	Our topic is all about changes from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will be looking at how people during this time lived and making comparisons with the Modern Age.
RE	Our question for this term is: <i>What can be learnt from New Testament Bible Stories?</i>
Computing	The children will be using their scientific knowledge to create branching databases based on food groups and animal classification. Also, we will be learning how to code programmes.
Music	We will be reading and composing rhythms using Bucket Drumming. 3FM will be learning beginner violin skills including bowing, plucking and reading notation.
PE	OAA – This will include team building skills. We will be creating a Stone Age dance based on story telling. Improving gymnastics (rolls and travelling) and football (hand-eye coordination and teamwork) skills.
RHE/PSHE	Our learning will be all about relationships, respect and celebrating differences.
Art/D&T	We will be using mixed media to create cave paintings and construct Bronze Age dwellings from natural materials.
