#### **Christmas Performances and Events**

We are now fully into the swing of Christmas! There are lots of events happening in the next two weeks, so the following will hopefully serve as a useful reference guide.



If your child is in Year 3 or Year 4, please remember to book your spaces for your child's Christmas performance – an email was sent home on Tuesday with the link to the online form. There are two performances per year group and each child is entitled to two tickets.

Reception and Year 1 performances are by class so tickets are not required – please just come to the school office at the time of your child's performance.

It is not too late to book your child's tickets for the KS1 Christmas Cinema Night and the KS2 Christmas Parties; tickets can be paid for via Arbor. Full information about these exciting events was sent home on the 21<sup>st</sup> November and we are delighted that 215 children are already signed up.







Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> December is our Christmas lunch day. The Diner is running a special themed menu – which is always incredibly popular – and children (and staff) can also wear festive jumpers / clothes on this day. The Christmas Lunch can be ordered and paid for in the normal way and there is no charge for coming to school in festive clothes.

#### Palestine / Israel assembly

In assembly this week, children in KS2 learned - in a child-appropriate way - about the tragic conflict taking place in Gaza. This was in response to the topic being so high-profile in the news every day and several parents approaching us to see how we might deal with this subject in school. Mrs Dunne met with some KS2 Change Champions and asked if they felt children should learn about the conflict in a child-appropriate way. All agreed they thought it was important to learn about other children in the world and so they helped with creating and delivering a presentation in assembly for children in Years 3 to 6.

At Gossops Green we feel it is important to acknowledge real life events that are dominating the news because our children are bombarded with images and words about this every day on social media and on television.

We try to approach news stories with sensitivity; share facts and information in a way that the children can understand and to demonstrate the importance of empathy with others around the world and of always having hope for a better world for children to live in.




#### Children in Need and Poppy Appeal
