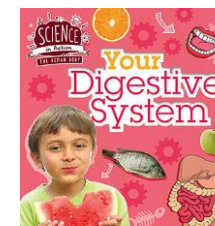




Learning for this term:	
English	We will read and study George's Marvellous Medicine and write an amazing character description to describe Grandma. We will also be exploring a range of non-fiction texts linked to teeth and the digestive system.
Maths	We will be learning about written methods for multiplication and division. We will also learn about fractions and decimals.
Science	We will be exploring teeth and we will then move onto learning more about the digestive system.
Geography	We will be revising our understanding of the equator, identifying hemispheres and will then begin to explore lines of longitude and latitude, as well as maps and symbols.
RE	We will be investigating why people choose to go on pilgrimages. After half term, we will be thinking about Easter.
Computing	We will be looking at how spreadsheets are constructed and how to format cells and produce line graphs.
Music	We will be practising basic strumming patterns using chords C and F major on the ukuleles.
PE	Activities will include: Gossops Green Mile Challenge. (4PS/4TM) Gymnastics/Cricket. (4WL) Swimming – Gaining confidence in the water.
PSHE	We will be discussing ways to keep ourselves safe and thinking about our rights and responsibilities.
Art	We will be looking closely at the cross section of different fruits, using shading skills to make a detailed sketch. We will then begin to explore watercolours too!
DT	We will be exploring micro: bits to program a simple object.
