RE: Year 6 Visit to the Imperial War Museum – Week Beginning 17th November 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that as part of our World War Two topic, we will be visiting the Imperial War Museum in the week beginning **Monday 17th November 2025**. This will be a valuable opportunity for the children to enrich their understanding of the subject through real-life artefacts and exhibitions.

The visits will take place on the following days:

- **6JE – Tuesday 18th November**
- **6LP – Wednesday 19th November**
- **6MH – Thursday 20th November**

To keep the cost low, and to give the children a further wider experience, they will be travelling by train. They will travel from Ifield to Elephant and Castle, with only a short 10-minute walk from the station to the museum.

In order to have the maximum amount of time at the museum, **we will be leaving school at 8:45am and returning by 4:15pm.**

Please ensure your child arrives at school at **8:30am promptly** so they can be registered and have time to use the toilet before we leave. Unfortunately, if your child is late and misses their class departing, they will miss the trip and will spend the day with another Year 6 class.

We kindly ask for a voluntary contribution of **£7.50, payable online via Arbor** to help cover the cost of the visit. Please note that if we do not receive sufficient contributions, we may unfortunately have to cancel the trip. **Permission must be given by Friday 7th November.**

Children are required to be in full school uniform and have a waterproof coat but have the option of wearing their PE trainers as there will be lots of walking.

All children will require a packed lunch and a bottle of water. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, (or would like a school packed lunch) the school is able to provide this, if you book one by midnight of the previous Thursday. Children will need a rucksack to carry their lunch in – to avoid them carrying anything in their hands.

If there is a problem with your child attending the trip, please let your child's class teacher know.
