Monday 6th October

All of Year 6 will be taking part in a morning of team building games and activities in the morning. They will have PPA in the afternoon as usual.

Tuesday 7th October

Pupils will need a packed lunch, extra drinks, coat and hat/scarf/gloves depending on weather (we will be walking there). As it is a physical activity, pupils may wear their PE kit for this trip. As this is a local trip, we do not need any permissions signed, but please speak to your child's class teacher if you have any questions.

If your child receives a free school lunch, or you have ordered school lunch via Arbor, a packed lunch will be provided.


Wednesday 8th, Thursday 9th and Friday 10th October
