RE: Spring Movie Night

Dear Parents and Carers,

As requested by the pupils last year, the spring term fundraising event will be a movie night rather than a disco this term. All profits from this event will go back into our School Fund where **every penny** goes towards resources for the children.



Movie Night

When: Wednesday 25th March
Straight from school until 4:30pm

Pupils should **not** bring a change of clothes or any of their own snacks, but they *are* welcome to bring a small blanket/pillow and a small cuddly teddy. Please bring these in a named carrier bag that will fit on their peg/in their locker.

Collection:

KS1 collection will be from their classroom doors as normal.

KS2 collection will be from the KS2 playground in their usual places. Please let us know via a note in the diary if children are going home with a different family member/family friend. Year 5/6 pupils can walk home if they normally do and have given consent.

KS1, KS2 and the gates near the shops will be opened at 4:20pm for pick up.



Water and squash will be provided, and we will refill pupils' own water bottles to help us reduce the number of disposable cups needed.

Pupils will also be given biscuits to enjoy with their movie. Please speak to your child's class teacher if they have any allergies and we can make alternative arrangements.

Movie nights will take place across year team classrooms and each year group will have a choice of two movies to choose from (in advance). All movies selected for Year 1 up to Year 4 will be rated 'U' and Year 5/6 may also be 'PG'. Your child or class teacher will be able to tell you the movies choices for their year group.



Please book your tickets via **Arbor**. Tickets cost **£3** per child. As we appreciate that money is tight at the moment, we would ask for a £3 contribution, but you are welcome to pay less (minimum is set to £1) if that enables your child to attend. **(You will need to book all of your children separately).**

On Arbor, please select 'Activities' then 'Trips' and you will see the Cinema Night allocated to your child.

Please note, that if you have booked your child into **Cygnets** on the day of their disco, you do NOT have to pay for a ticket as you are already paying for them to be in school. Please could you inform Mrs Wilson if they would like to attend.

If your child is not at school on the day, or goes home ill, they will NOT be permitted to attend the movie night.
