Dear Parents and Carers,

We are thrilled to announce that rehearsals for our upcoming Year 6 production are soon to be underway! Your child worked hard during auditions, and we are delighted to share that they have been selected for the role of _____.

This production is a wonderful opportunity for the children to celebrate their final year at the school, build confidence, and showcase their incredible talents.

To ensure every child has the opportunity to shine, we have divided the cohort into **Cast A** and **Cast B**. However, it is important to note that **all children will perform twice**.

- **Cast A** will take the lead during one afternoon and one evening performance.
- **Cast B** will take the lead during the alternate afternoon and evening performances.

Even when a child is not in the "lead" cast for a specific show, they are an integral part of the production as ensemble members and vital support/backup for their peers. Therefore, **all children are expected to be present for all evening performances**. This ensures we have a full, vibrant stage and a safety net for their castmates.

To help the children get into character, please find below a suggested costume list for your child's specific role. We aim to keep costumes simple and cost-effective, so please do check what you might already have at home that is similar to the suggested outfit.

Please could costumes be in school on a **named hanger** by Friday 19th June.

Character	Costume Description
Head Villain	Dark clothing, a cape
Wilhelm & Jacob	Dressed like smart gentlemen- white shirt, tie. Possibly a dark coat.
Evil Queen	Large cape, crown, dark dress. Possibly a large necklace.
Witch	Dark, raggedy clothes.
Pied-Piper	A hat and jacket in matching colours.
Fifi & Gigi	Very over-the-top, colourful dresses.
Rumpel	Boots, coloured shirt, tie, waistcoat.
Wulf	Large, grey, furry ears and a tail in the same colour. Grey clothing.
Cinders	A dress in rags, with an apron.
Maids	Aprons, mop caps.
Ernie & Bernie	White shirt with black tie, waistcoat or jacket (or both).
Hansel	Dungarees and shirt.
Gretel	Dungarees and shirt, hair in plaits.
Birds	Bright, colourful clothing – ideally same colour top & bottoms.
Frank	Dressed like a smart gentleman, with a waistcoat, white shirt, tie.
Wolves	Large, grey, furry ears and a tail in the same colour. Grey clothing.
Millie	A crown and a smart dress or skirt with fancy blouse/shirt.
Red	Red cape, boots, dark top and bottoms.
Fairy Godmother	Skirt or dress, wings and a wand.
Royal Announcer	Smart shirt and trousers.
Prince Charming	White shirt, dark trousers.
Footmen	Smart shirt and trousers.
Huntsman	Outdoor jacket in a dark colour, like green or brown.
Granny	Floral blouse and a skirt.
